The 12 pairs of cranial nerves originate from the nose (CN I), the eyes (CN II), the inner ear (CN VIII), the brainstem (CN III-XII) and the spinal cord (part of XI). Cranial nerves have sensory (afferent) and motor (efferent) functions.

There are 12 pairs of cranial nerves. They arise from their nuclei in brain cortex and brain stem. They supply motor fibers and bring sensory fibers from head and neck except few exceptions. The names of most of these cranial nerves are related to their function and that makes it easy to learn their names.

12 Cranial Nerves Mnemonic - All Medical Stuff

Each of the 12 cranial nerves has a specific function that helps the brain control the actions of the body. The olfactory nerve is involved in the sense of smell. This nerve has access to the cerebral cortex, but does not pass through the thalamus like other cranial nerves. The optic nerve is involved in the sense of sight.
