Frege introduced the notion of "sense" (German: Sinn) to accommodate difficulties in his early theory of meaning.: 965 First, if the entire significance of a sentence consists of its truth value, it follows that the sentence will have the same significance if we replace a word of the sentence with one having an identical reference, as this will not change its truth value.
